# 4th MEETING OF THE HYDROGRAPHIC SERVICES AND STANDARDS COMMITTEE (HSSC) AND ASSOCIATED IHO ECDIS STAKEHOLDERS' FORUM

25-28 September 2012, Taunton, United Kingdom

Reference: CL 15/2012 dated 6 February - HSSC, 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting, IHB, Monaco, 8-10 Nov 2011

Dear Hydrographer,

- The 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Hydrographic Services and Standards Committee (HSSC-4) will take place from 25-28 September 2012 at the Somerset County Cricket Ground, Taunton, UK, kindly hosted by the United Kingdom Hydrographic Office (UKHO). Attention is drawn to the closing time for the meeting 1630 on Friday 28 September. In the circumstances, and noting the need to travel from Taunton to connect to international airlines (limited connections via Bristol, most connections via London), delegates are recommended to consider commencing their return journey on the following day.
- This letter provides information on administrative details, the current status of actions arising from HSSC-3 (IHB, Monaco, 8-10 November 2011); and sets out a draft agenda and timetable for HSSC-4 and a programme for the IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum.
- Participation in HSSC-4 is open to all IHO Member States, and up to two delegates each representing Observer States and Non-Governmental International Organisations (NGIOs) recognised by the IHO. Registration forms for all delegates intending to participate in HSSC-4 should be submitted to the HSSC Secretariat (michel.huet@iho.int), copy to the UKHO (June.Thompson@UKHO.gov.uk) by 31 July 2012.
- 4 <u>IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum</u>. An IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum will be held at the same venue as HSSC-4 on the afternoon of 26 September and the morning of 27 September. This forum is open to all-comers that register their intention to attend. Registration forms for the IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum should be submitted to the HSSC Secretariat (<u>michel.huet@iho.int</u>), copy to the UKHO (<u>June.Thompson@UKHO.gov.uk</u>) by 31 July 2012. Registered delegates to HSSC-4 will automatically be assumed to be attending the IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum unless they indicate otherwise.
- 5 <u>HSSC Chair Group meeting</u>. HSSC-4 will be preceded by an informal meeting of the HSSC Chair Group during the afternoon of 24 September. In addition to the Chair of HSSC, this meeting will comprise the Chairs of HSSC Working Groups (WGs), plus the Vice-Chair and Secretary of HSSC.
- 6 <u>Venue and Accommodation</u>. The meeting will be held at the Somerset County Cricket Ground in Taunton, UK. Logistics information, such as details of available hotels, and registration forms for HSSC-4 and the IHO ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum have been posted on the IHO website (<a href="http://www.iho-ohi.net/mtg\_docs/com\_wg/HSSC/HSSC4/HSSC4Docs.htm">http://www.iho-ohi.net/mtg\_docs/com\_wg/HSSC/HSSC4/HSSC4Docs.htm</a>). Attendees should book their chosen hotel at their earliest convenience.
- 7 <u>Election of Chair and Vice-Chair</u>. Rule 2.3 of the Rules of Procedure for HSSC states: "The election of the Chair and Vice-Chair shall be decided at the first meeting after each ordinary session of the Conference and shall be determined by vote of the Member States present and voting". As HSSC-4 will be the first meeting following the XVIII<sup>th</sup> International Hydrographic Conference, an election for the

positions of Chair and Vice-Chair of HSSC will be conducted immediately before the close of the meeting. Accordingly, Member States are invited to consider proposing candidates for the positions of Chair and Vice-Chair of HSSC.

- 8 Actions arising from HSSC-3. The status of all actions arising from HSSC-3 is summarized in Annex A. Some actions are still pending. Those nominated for actions that remain outstanding are kindly requested to take action as necessary and report the status to the HSSC Secretariat (michel.huet@iho.int) as soon as possible.
- 9 <u>Draft Agenda and timetable for HSSC-4 and Programme for the IHO ECDIS Stakeholders'</u>
  Forum. A provisional agenda and time table for HSSC-4 and a programme for the IHO Stakeholders'
  Forum is provided in **Annex B**. Associated documents, where known, have been listed. Member States are kindly requested to review the draft agenda and programme and provide any comments or proposals for new or amended subjects to the Secretary, by 31 July 2012. If necessary, a revised draft agenda and programme will be prepared and published on the IHO website.
- 10 <u>Submission Deadline for HSSC-4 Documents</u>. Documents intended for consideration at HSSC-4 should be submitted to the HSSC Secretariat in accordance with the "<u>Instructions for the Submission of Reports and Proposals for Consideration by HSSC</u>", as follows:

- All documents will be placed on the IHO website as and when they are received.
- The current list of HSSC contacts is provided in **Annex C**. Any changes should be forwarded to the HSSC Secretariat at the earliest opportunity.
- Possible Sequential Meeting of the WEND WG. A meeting of the WEND Working Group may take place, also in Taunton, either during the week preceding or following HSSC-4. This has not yet been confirmed. If this meeting takes place, an announcement will be made separately by IHO Circular Letter and published on the IHO website and at the first opportunity.
