

1. **Background:** NAVAREA XIII and coastal warnings for the areas that are not yet covered by NAVTEX transmissions are promulgated via INMARSAT POR satellite. SafetyNET NAVAREA XIII warnings are transmitted twice a day at 0930 and 2130 UTC.

2. **Comments:** Due to the climate features the volume of navigational warning messages has seasonal dependence. The quantity of SafetyNET navigational warning messages that have been promulgated are shown in the table below:
