- New version of the Use of the Object Catalogue completed



Problems or outstanding issues

- The absence of a S-100 Portrayal module will potentially delay S-101. In addition to this there are other organizations taking up S-100 who will have the same problem
- Available resources versus expectations



- + S-100
 - Interest in and use of continues to increase
 - Intention of a version 2.0.0 in 2013 to include
 - Corrections based on development of product specification
 - Part 9 Portrayal
- S-102 Bathymetric Surface Product Specification
 - Published April 2012



- + S-101
 - Phase 1 complete
 - Phase 2 complete
 - Phase 3 complete
 - Phase 4 ongoing, anticipated completion date January 2013, but dependant on the completion of S-100 Part 9 Portrayal
 - Data Classification and Encoding Guide (Equivalent to S-57 UoC)
 - A significant part of S-101 which will be completed on time, but will be subject to constant review during the test period
 - Implementation Rules is an annex which will document how data must be used or displayed in ECDIS



- S-101 Impact Study
 - On line survey closes end of October
 - Returns for the survey to date are:
 - HOs = 50
 - Software Producers = 20
 - Mariners = 49
 - ECDIS Manufactures = 21
 - RENCs and VARs = 10
 - Ship Owners = 29
 - Full report will follow after TSMAD have reviewed the results



- + S-57 Appendix B1, Annex A Use of the Object Catalogue
 - New version prepared to include numerous encoding bulletins published since the last edition
- + S-64 IHO Test Data
 - New edition in preparation including a more comprehensive set of test data.
 - Meeting with stakeholders in October to discuss new framework
 - Two polar data sets will be available shortly for stakeholder review and comment before including in the new edition.



- + S-58 Recommended ENC Validation Checks
 - 425 Checks restructured into Critical Errors, Minor Error and Warnings
 - 75% of checks reworded using programmatic syntax
 - 80% of 425 checks encoded in new test data sets
 - Ongoing consideration is being given on how to ensure ENCs are validated to a minimum standard based on the Critical Error category of checks
 - Scheduled to be completed for endorsement by HSSC5

 - TSMAD assist the development of a draft guide to developing S-100 based product specifications
 - EU BLAST Project
 - UK TSMAD rep presented on S-100 at BLAST Conference in Belgium

 - UK TSMAD rep presented on S-100 at workshop hosted by Norwegian Coastal Administration and the Singapore MPA
 - ISO TC211
 - IHO sign MOU with ISO
 - TSMAD through IHB rep continues to attend and monitor activities.
