Terms of Reference

+ Following CL84/2012, amend CSPCWG's Terms of Reference, noting S-4 remains outside Resolution 2/2007 but S-11A and S-49 are now included.

+ 2. Authority

This WG is a subsidiary of the Hydrographic Services and Standards Committee (HSSC). Its work is subject to HSSC approval.

In respect of the current cycle of revision of S-4 and in the interests of procedural efficiency, the WG has authority to reach decisions on the maintenance and updating of this document [for which it is responsible] and to seek direct endorsement of its proposals by IHO Member States via the IHB. This does not include matters that may have a strategic or financial implication for Member States or other interested stakeholders.
