4. Main items under consideration

4.1. ENC development

With the phased-in implementation of the ECDIS from 2012 and the growing number of ENCs, EAHC Member States (MS) recognized the urgent need to address ENC overlaps, gaps and data harmonization which could lead to unstable ECDIS performance. MS also recognized that those issues could be addressed based on regional and bilateral discussions. At the 4th EAHC Coordinating Meeting in January 2010, the timeline for addressing those issues was set and EAHC ENC Task Group has been tasked to produce harmonized small scale ENCs. For larger scale ENC, the issues will be resolved based on multilateral, bilateral or national basis.

4.2. Meetings

The following meetings were and will be held based on urgent needs to meet the ECDIS implementation timeline. In general, the Coordinating Meeting is held at about the beginning of the year followed by at least 2 EAHC ENC Task Group Meetings.

4.4. Japan Capacity Building Project

4.4.1. 3 February 2010 3rd Coordination Meeting (Japan)

The meeting evaluated the course conducted in 2009 and discussed the contents and schedule of the training course which will be held from September to December 2010. In addition, it was agreed to establish an association of former students of the training course in order to share information and maintain their network.

4.4.2. 16 April 2010 4th Coordination Meeting (Monaco)

The selection board examined all the documentation received. The candidates from Latvia, New Zealand, Thailand, Ukraine, Uruguay and Vietnam were finally selected for the course that will be run at the UK Hydrographic Office, from 06 September to 17 December 2010.

5. General aspects

The EAHC website has proven to be a useful medium of storing and disseminating information to MS. EAHC also has ENC websites for MS to access and housing all the SCS updates and quality check reports. However, at present there are some layout shortfalls including the lack of specific domain name, the marked difference of domain names, the difference of look and feel of each site, and the dependence upon IT support for creation and management. Therefore, the new, unified EAHC website has been developed and will be launched at the 5th EAHC ENC Task Group Meeting.

6. Conclusions

Over the next two year, the ENC harmonization will be the main focus of the region. EAHC will develop mechanism to enhance MS capacity in hydrography and cartography to support safety of navigation.
