BACKGROUND

International Hydrographic Organization

- S-101 will include the portrayal specifications for presentation of S-101 ENC on ECDIS
 - S-57 ENCs have their presentation rules defined in S-52
- Most features will have their S-52 portrayal taken into S-101 as is
- However, in S-101 there exists new features and significantly remodeled features, that have no clear direct S-52 equivalent entry
- NCWG2 agreed to assist S101PT in identifying features that require symbols, and later to propose them



PROGRESS SO FAR

International Hydrographic Organization

- Initial review was done by C Harmon and J Wootton to slim done the list received from S100WG
 - This review indicated that majority of the features will not need completely new symbol, but existing symbol may be utilized
- It was agreed that the list of possible features requiring new symbols to be worked on by volunteers in order identify the final recommendations for new symbols
- During the preparation of the list for the volunteers it was noted, that input list had become out of date
 - → Chair halted further progress and asked S101PT to provide an updated input

STATUS NOW

International Hydrographic Organization

- S101PT provided updated list of new and remodeled in September 2019
- List contains
 - 36 new features (including existing features with new allowed geometric primitives)
 - ~ 400 new feature-attribute and feature-attributeenumerate value combinations

- Slimming down the list provided by S101PT (FI)
- Preliminary analysis of the required symbols (FI)
- Analysis and drafting recommendations (FI, IT, TR, DE, US-NOAA, US-NGA)
- Review by NCWG
- Delivering the recommendatations to S101PT (May 2020)
