At the last EAtHC Conference in 2004, the IHO membership was 73 MSs.

In 2004 the IHO was pleased to receive Myanmar as the 74th MS.

In 2005 the IHO was pleased to receive Latvia and Mauritius as 75^{th} and 76^{th} MS of the organization.

Nowadays, there are 6 more States that after having received two third majority support to become IHO Member States, they have not yet deposit their instrument of accession. These six countries are:

- Bulgaria (since 1992)
- Mauritania (since 1991)
- Qatar (since 1993)
- Romania (since 2005)
- Saudi Arabia (since 2005)
- Ireland (since 2006)

Finally, the IHB records two countries that are in the process of obtaining the required majority to become IHO MSs, they are:

- Cameroon
- Sierra Leone.
