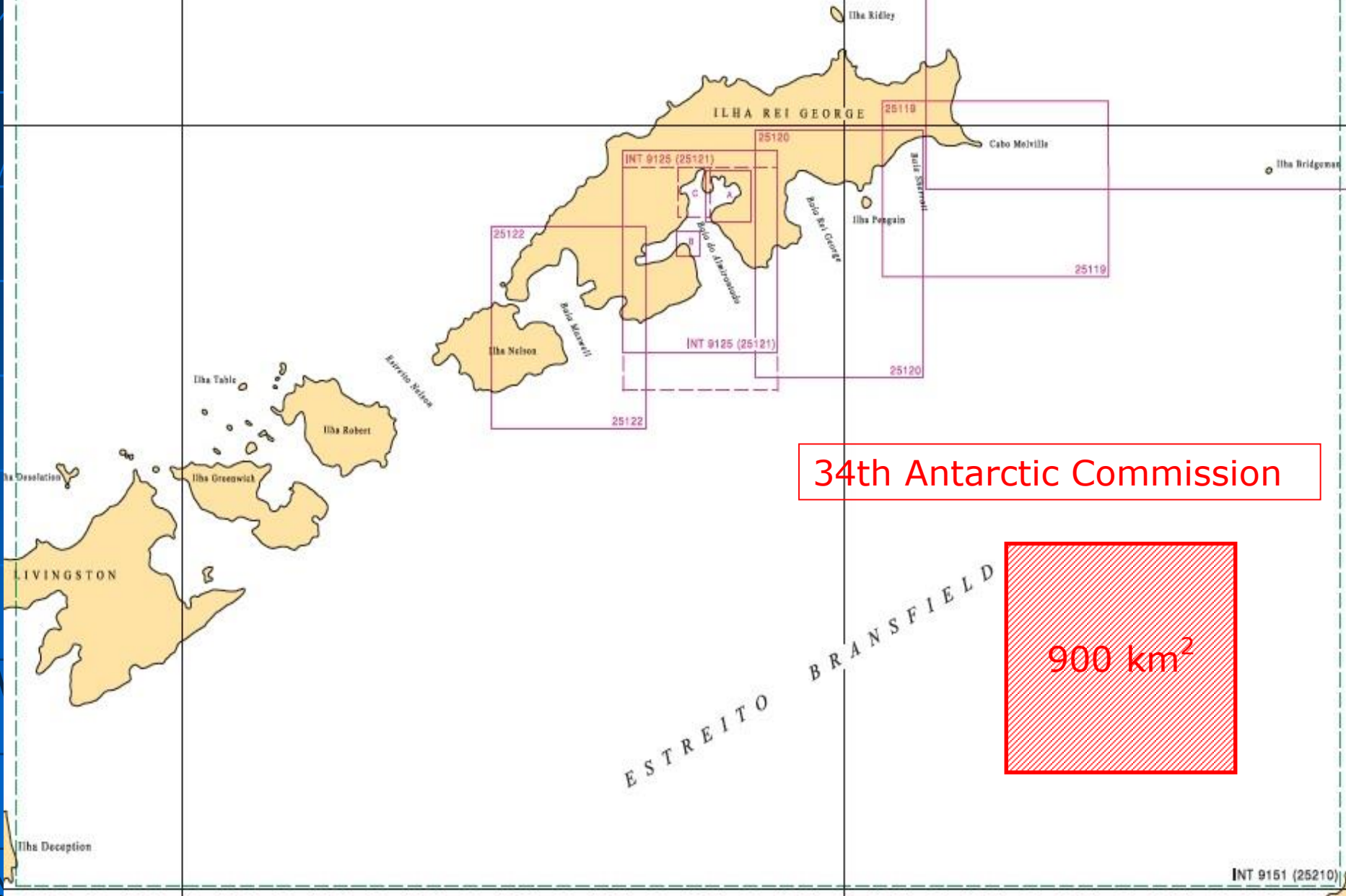
Survey and charting progress in Antarctica since last meeting (December 2013)

Areas Surveyed

During the 34th Antarctic Commission (OPERANTAR XXXIV), performed by the Brazilian Navy Ships ALMIRANTE MAXIMIANO (Polar Ship) and ALMIRANTE ARY RONGEL (Oceanographic Support Ship), bathymetric surveys using single beam and multibeam echosounder were conducted in areas covered by the nautical charts 25210 (INT 9151) - De Isla de Jorge a Isla Livingston.
