## **Establishment of EU Marine and Maritime Policies Working Group**

The North Sea Hydrographic Commission, during its 27<sup>th</sup> Conference, in Rostock, Germany, September 2006;

**Noting** that significant new European directives and programmes on marine and maritime matters have been launched or are currently under development,

**Resolved** to establish a working group on EU marine and maritime policies to monitor the impact on HOs with the following terms of reference:

- 1. identify EU activities and processes on matters of interest to HOs;
- 2. establish a common understanding of the issues when possible;
- 3. consider and propose the ways and channels to interface with the EU activities and processes (mechanisms) through NSHC initiatives or through the IHO in general.
