IC-ENC does not edit or modify the data provide by the HO, the ENC remains the property and responsibility of the producing nation <u>at all times</u>


- Software analysis and testing

# **Data Management Database**

- Used to register and monitor data
- Collates and automatically classifies errors produced from validation software






**Horizontal comparison**

# **The Validation Report**

- A Validation Report is produced for every validated ENC file
- Created from the error classifications and decision making from validation
- Reports issues back to HO
- Can be tailored to the HO via the Partnership Agreement



# **Facilitating New Coverage**

- IC-ENC act as coordinators for consistency between HOs in resolution of overlap and gaps
- Coordinate cancellation and replacement coverage on behalf of new members
