19th CONFERENCE OF THE INTERNATIONAL CARTOGRAPHIC ASSOCIATION (Ottawa, Canada, 14-21 August 1999)

Nautical Chart Display by IHO Member States

Reference: IHB Circular Letter 61/1998 of 23 December 1998

Dear Sir.

IHB Circular Letter 61/1998 proposed holding a display of IHO Member States' cartographic products at the above ICA Conference. Thirteen Member States have responded, twelve of whom have expressed their intention to participate. A summary of the replies is given in Annex A.

- 2. It is therefore confirmed that an IHO Member States' Chart Exhibition will be held at the same time as the ICA Conference. The IHB considers that it is desirable that as many Member States as possible participate in this exhibition in order to promote the work of HOs and of the IHO. Those who have not yet replied are therefore urged to do so.
- 3. The Canadian Hydrographic Service has kindly appointed Ms. Sheila ACHESON as the IHO-ICA'99 Coordinator for the IHO Chart Exhibition at ICA'99. She will arrange for help to mount the IHO Member States' displays. She will also assist any Member State who may require a computer for its display. Ms. ACHESON can be contacted directly at achesons@dfo-mpo.gc.ca. Ing. en chef Michel HUET, IHB Professional Assistant for Cartography, will liaise with Ms. ACHESON in order to organize the exhibition and he will represent the IHB at the ICA Conference.
- 4. The cartographic material for the IHO Chart Exhibition at ICA'99 should be sent **by 31 May 1999** to the following address (English or French):

5. The return of any material will be at the expense of the Member State concerned. This should be arranged between a representative of the Member State and the local CHS co-ordinator, Ms. ACHESON.

- 6. The IHO Chart Exhibition will be available for viewing during the same period as the International Map Exhibition of ICA'99, that is, from noon on Monday 16 August to the end of the day on Friday 20 August 1999.
- 7. It is confirmed that a prize will be awarded to the best Member State display. The decision on the exhibit award will be taken by a jury appointed by the ICA Commission on Marine Cartography.
- 8. An "INPUT FORM" to indicate the details of the exhibited products is at Annex B. This is for use by those Member States who have not yet provided this information or who intend to participate in the exhibition but have not yet informed the IHB. Completed forms should be sent to the Chair, International Map Exhibition Committee, ICA'99 (Ms Betty KIDD, National Archives of Canada, bkidd@archives.ca), with a copy to the IHB, before 31 May 1999. This information is not required of Finland, France, Germany and Greece, who have already provided the necessary details.
