## RESIGNATION OF IHO MEMBER OF FIG/IHO INTERNATIONAL ADVISORY BOARD ON STANDARDS OF COMPETENCE FOR HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEYORS AND NOMINATION OF NEW MEMBER

We have been informed by Japan that Mr. T. TATSUNO has had to resign from the FIG/IHO International Advisory Board on Standards of Competence for Hydrographic Surveyors and the Directing Committee therefore wishes to proceed with the selection and appointment of a successor to represent the IHO on the Board.

Captain David MacFARLAND, Director, Coast Survey (USA-NOS/NOAA) has proposed Captain Andrew ARMSTRONG (USA) to fill this vacancy. Member States are requested to forward other nominations, if any, by 31 December 1999.

It would be very much appreciated if nominations could be forwarded to the IHB by the end of December 1999, as the next meeting of the Advisory Board is to be held in mid-April 2000 in Valparaiso, Chile.
