IMO/IHO/IMA CO-OPERATION ARRANGEMENT ON HYDROGRAPHIC AND NAUTICAL CARTOGRAPHY COURSES CONDUCTED AT THE INTERNATIONAL MARITIME ACADEMY - TRIESTE

<u>Taking into account</u> the framework of co-operation between the International Maritime Organization (IMO) and the International Hydrographic Organization (IHO), as prescribed under IMO Assembly Resolution A64(1963);

<u>Recognizing</u> the long-term co-operation between IHO and IMA with respect to the development and conduct of hydrographic courses at IMA;

<u>Recognizing</u> the priority afforded to capacity-building and human resource development through maritime training under the IMO Integrated Technical Co-operation Programme;

Now therefore the three parties agree as follows:

The International Hydrographic Organization shall:

- 1. Support the courses in Hydrography and Nautical Cartography implemented at IMA through the following activities:
 - 1.1 co-operation in the drafting of the syllabi for the Hydrographic and Nautical Cartography courses in accordance with the standards established by the FIG-IHO;
 - the provision of lecturers for the courses from the Hydrographic Services of voluntary IHO Member States and from the IHO Secretariat (IHB);
 - 1.3 the dissemination of information on the hydrographic courses held in IMA through IHO Circular Letters addressed to all IHO Member States and to a number of potential recipients:
 - the participation in the selection of the applicants for each hydrographic and nautical cartography course; and
 - 1.5 the support of the Hydrographic Offices of IHO Member States, where applicable, to provide supplementary training onboard their survey vessels and facilities

The IMA shall:

- 2.1 organize and co-ordinate the Hydrography and Nautical Cartography courses;
- 2.2 provide secretarial, logistical, and administrative support;
- 2.3 administrate the funds provided by **IMO** and other donor sources;
- 2.4 draft the syllabi for the courses in accordance with the *FIG/IHO* standards; and

2.5 submit courses for recognition from the FIG/IHO Advisory Board.

The IMO shall:

- 3.1 assist, where practicable, in the mobilization of resources from external sources of funding, including donor agencies, donor countries, and regional bodies, in support of the conduct of Hydrography and Nautical Cartography courses at IMA;
- 3.2 provide technical assistance to IMA in accordance with the priorities of the IMO Integrated Technical Co-operation Programme and availability of funding; and
- 3.3 report to IMO governing bodies, including the Council and the Technical Co-operation Committee, on activities undertaken at IMA.

Additional provisions

The co-operation arrangement contained herein will run for a period of **two years**, which may be renewed on an annual basis with the written agreement of the parties.

This co-operation arrangement shall be reviewed on a regular basis <u>normally</u> once a year, and shall be subject to available funding, with no expectation of renewal and continuation.

This co-operation arrangement may be terminated by any party giving three (3) months' written notice to the other parties.

The terms of this co-operation arrangement can be modified in writing by mutual consent of IMO, IHO and IMA (Trieste).
