RESIGNATION OF IHO MEMBER OF FIG/IHO/ICA INTERNATIONAL ADVISORY BOARD ON STANDARDS OF COMPETENCE FOR HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEYORS AND NAUTICAL CARTOGRAPHERS AND NOMINATION OF NEW MEMBER

Dear Hydrographer,

We have been informed by India that Rear Admiral K. Srinivasan has had to resign from the FIG/IHO/ICA International Advisory Board on Standards of Competence for Hydrographic Surveyors and Nautical Cartographers. The Directing Committee therefore wishes to proceed with the selection and appointment of a successor to represent the IHO on the Advisory Board.

The Chief Hydrographer of India and the Hydrographer of Italy have respectively proposed Cmde RB Jayaraman and Professor Luciano Surace as a replacement to fill this vacancy. Member States are requested to forward other nominations, if any, by 31 October 2002. Any proposal of a candidate should be accompanied by a detailed curriculum vitae.

- 1. Board Members are expected to attend every annual meeting of the Board and to conduct business by correspondence between meetings.
- 2. Board Members are expected to be supported by their own organization for travel expenses and work.
