We would like to remind you that the Centenary commemoration of the General Bathymetric Chart of the Oceans (GEBCO), which was initiated by Prince Albert 1st of Monaco, will take place in Monaco on 14-16 April 2003 (IHB CL 33/2002). The whole event will include a Conference, a technical ocean mapping exhibition, social events, as well as the unveiling of a commemorative plaque during the Opening Ceremony. This event is jointly organized by the International Hydrographic Organization (IHO) and the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC), with contribution from the Government of Monaco, through a Centenary Organizing Committee chaired by Sir Anthony Laughton, Chairman of GEBCO.

To date only 8 Hydrographic Offices have confirmed their participation.
