Captain V. D. Fomchenko is a member of a number of Editorial Boards for the International Bathymetric Charts of the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (of UNESCO). He was awarded the Prize of the Government of the Russian Federation for the creation of the Chart of the Bottom Relief of the Arctic Ocean (2002).
