## CIRCULAR LETTER 54/2003 31 July 2003

## **PROPOSED IHO WORK PROGRAMME & BUDGET FOR 2004**

References: a) IHB CL 29/2003

Dear Hydrographer,

In accordance with the Work Programme Planning Cycle approved by Decision 14 b) of the XVIth I.H. Conference, and based on the Work Programme 2003-2007 approved by Decision 14 a) of the XVIth IHC, the enclosed IHO Work Programme and Budget are provided for Member States' review, comment and approval. **Your approval is required by 30 October 2003 using the form at Annex D.** 

The IHB has made the following changes in the presentation of the Work Programme to enhance its clarity and utility:

- ?? The IHO Work Programme 2003-2007 (Annex A) has been modified to provide a clear indication on the timing in which the tasks and other activities corresponding to the objectives of each programme (1 to 5) are to be performed. Your comments as to the usefulness of this tabular form and the scheduling of specific tasks are encouraged.
- ?? The wording of specific Tasks and Objectives used in the IHO Work Programme 2003-2007 has been revised to be more self-explanatory. The expected activity is more clearly stated and the differentiation between Objective (a goal) and Task (an activity) is more closely followed. Your comments are welcomed with respect to these clarifying changes.
- ?? The IHO 2004 Work Program (Annex B) is explicitly broken-out from the 5-year work programme.

With regard to the substance of the Work Programme the following changes have been incorporated in the documents at Annexes A and B:


- ?? **Programme 2, Capacity Building, Task 2.1.9** The Marine Electronic Highway Project (Malacca Strait) is added to reflect IHO participation in this endeavour.
- ?? **Programme 3, Techniques and Standards, Objective 3.1.1** The WEND Task Group is noted as a subsidiary body of WEND Committee with meetings scheduled as required during 2004.
- ?? **Programme 5, IHO Development, Task 5.1.1** reflects the activities associated with the SPWG.

**Member States' comments and approval of this Work Programme are requested by 30 October 2003**. Changes proposed by Member States will be considered by IHB when preparing the final version of the 2004 Programme that will be implemented by January 2004. Please find at Annex C the "IHO 2004 Proposed Budget", prepared in accordance to the 2004 Work Programme and Five Year Budget approved by the XVIth IH Conference. Your attention is drawn to the following adjustments made in the preparation of this budget:

- ?? **A. Contributions** Increased 3% from 2,316,468€ to 2,386,780€ with the addition of Kuwait as a member state, an adjustment in the tonnage of Yugoslavia, the restoration of Guatemala. The number of shares has increased to 617 and the provision for non-payment by suspended member states has reduced to 6 shares.
- ?? I. **Personnel Costs** Increased 3% from 1,715,058€ to 1,766,904€ due to normal promotion of staff, regulated changes in entitlements and inflation costs.
- ?? **I. d) Payment to Retirement Funds** Increased 27% from 144,069€ to 182,691€ to cover the required payment to the retirement plans of current employees. The level of this payment is set by regulations.
- ?? I. m) Pensions to retired staff Reduced 18% from 164,786€ to 135,000€ due to refinement of forecast pension payments.
- ?? **II. a) Maintenance of IT equipment** Increased 85% from 20,720€ to 38,450€ to reflect greater sophistication of IT systems and increased reliance on contract maintenance.
- ?? II. j) Consultancy Expenses Reduced 23% from 123,484€ to 95,000€ (IIg & IIi) as forecast increased use of consultants has not materialized.

The above changes and other minor adjustments in the IHO 2004 Proposed budget are not of the magnitude to require a 2/3-majority approval of all Member States; however, **Members States' are required to approve the proposed budget using the form at Annex D by 30 October 2003**.

One final financial matter warranting your attention involves Decision 21 a) of the XVI<sup>th</sup> IHC that established a Working Group of the Finance Committee to study matters related to the alignment of IHB salaries to the UN system. The Directing Committee is pleased to announce the completion of this study and its resulting report. The report will be studied in a special meeting of the Finance Committee Officers to be held in late September 2003. Subsequently, the Working Group's report, together with the comments of the FCO, will be sent to Member States for comment. Based on the comments received from Member States, the Finance Committee will consider the implementation of the Working Group's recommendations and the need for adjustments to the budget that would require Member States' approval.
