With reference to the above, the ABLOS Conference on Addressing Difficult Issues in UNCLOS was held at the IHB from 28 to 30 October 2003.

The Conference was a great success with 88 delegates from 31 countries attending. Amongst the attendees were Delegates representing 22 Member States, 10 other Government departments, 12 business groups, 9 academic institutions and 3 International Organizations. Day 1 of the Conference included 6 tutorial sessions on: Height Reference Systems, The Normal Baseline, Maritime Zones and Jurisdictions, National considerations when negotiating a maritime Boundary, Completing an Article 76 Desktop Study and Deepwater Non-Living Marine Resources. On days 2 and 3 there were 22 papers covering topics on hydrography, oceanography, geodesy, law, computing, GIS and marine research.
