The 2005 ABLOS biennial conference, as notified in the References was held at the IHB from 10 – 12 October 2005.

The conference was very successful with 79 delegates from 25 countries attending. The delegates included representatives from 20 Hydrographic Offices, 26 other government departments, 5 business groups, 8 academic institutions, 1 Intergovernmental Organization and 1 Non-Governmental Organization. The first day of the conference was devoted to tutorial sessions on matters related to UNCLOS Article 76 and was attended by 29 delegates. The seminar on days 2 and 3 included 18 papers on many topics related to the theme of the Conference "Marine Scientific Research and the Law of the Sea: the Balance between Coastal State and International Rights".
