CIRCULAR LETTER 12/2005 21 January 2005

REVISED SECTION B-100 FOR CHART SPECIFICATIONS OF THE IHO (M-4)

<u>References</u>: 1) Publication M-4 – Part B: Chart Specifications of the IHO.

2) Publication M-3: Technical Resolutions of the IHO.

Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. The Chart Specifications and Paper Chart Working Group (CSPCWG) has put in hand a complete review and revision of M-4 Part B, building on work already begun by the former Chart Standardization Committee (CSC).
- 2. The aims of the review and revision of M-4 Part B are:
 - To insert new specifications, and update existing ones, changing paragraph numbers only if absolutely necessary.
 - To include references to digital charts, S-52 and S-57 in the introductory sections and improve M-4 Part B's compatibility with S-52 and S-57.
 - To make the wording more prescriptive where possible, continuing the progress which has been made towards greater international standardization over the last 15-20 years, exemplified by the publication of S-52 and S-57.
 - To clarify that the role of M-4, Part B is two-fold, that is it provides:
 - o An explanation of the general concepts and rationale behind the symbology used in charting, much of which is relevant to both digital and paper charts and
 - o Specific guidance for paper charts, including the use of text and symbology.
 - 3. The CSPCWG has completed a revision of the <u>first section of M-4 Part B (B-100)</u>, which is available on the IHO website (<u>www.iho.shom.fr</u> > Committees > CHRIS > CSPCWG > IHO Publication M-4), for Member States to examine.
 - 4. Noteworthy changes from the original section B-100 are as follows:
 - New introductory paragraphs B-100.1-3.
 - Extracts from SOLAS Chapter V included in paragraph B-102.
 - B-110.6 (reference to lattice overprints) deleted.
 - New paragraphs B-120.1-5 explaining conventions used within M-4.

- Changes to the scale groups at B-126 to improve consistency with other IHO guidance, such as S-57, M-4 Part A and M-11 Part A ('Guidance for the Preparation and Maintenance of INT chart schemes' not yet published).
- Conventions for Bearings has been moved from B-263 to B-132, and updated from TR A2.6.
- B-140 expanded to cover the use of additional colours resulting from the increasing use of new printing technology.
- B-170 expanded to cover 'ZOC' diagrams.
- B-177 'Preferred Areas' and B-178 'Reliability diagrams' deleted (following evidence that these are no longer used).
- A new section B-180 on Catalogues and Index Charts is derived from TR B1.12.

Note: It is proposed to move sections B-170 to B-178 into B-200 when that section is revised, as this is a more suitable place.

- 5. Revised French and Spanish versions of Section B-100 of M-4 will be prepared at the IHB.
- 6. IHO Technical Resolutions A2.6, B1.12, B3.3 and B3.18 have been included in the proposed revision, and it is proposed to cancel them when the proposed revision of M-4 Part B-100 comes into force.
- 7. Member States are requested to complete the response form in **Annex A** and review the proposed revision. According to Specification B-160, MS should inform the IHB (info@ihb.mc) if they have any major objections to the adoption of the revised section B-100, or any other comments, within three months. Therefore, the response form and MS' comments should reach the IHB no later than **21 April 2005**. If no objections are received, the IHB will announce in a follow-up Circular Letter that the revised section has come into force.
- 8. The IHB takes this opportunity to express its gratitude to the CSPCWG¹ and its Secretariat at the UKHO² for this valuable achievement and, as a general note, for the remarkable work that has been accomplished so far by this WG.
