## **Credentials / Experience of SCUFN Nominees**

## 1. LCdr Harvinder AVTAR (India)

Holds a Master's Degree in Hydrographic Surveying from Goa University, India. Has eleven years of experience in hydrography in Indian waters and has been closely associated with the chart production process at the National Hydrographic Office since 2003. Well versed with marine geology and bathymetry of Indian region. Member of the Indian National Cartographic Association since 2000.

## 2. LCdr Rafael PONCE Urbina (Mexico)

Holds a Master's Degree in Hydrographic Sciences and a Category A Certificate in Hydrography (FIG-IHO). Currently, Deputy-Director for Hydrography and Cartography.

# 3. Capt Albert E. Theberge (USA)

Has been active in both the bathymetric community and the history of oceanography community. During his 27-year career with NOAA Corps, he commanded two survey vessels and served in various capacities on hydrographic and bathymetric surveying vessels, as well as mobile geodetic and hydrographic field parties. Served as NOAA Office of Minerals and Energy liaison to Scripps Institution of Oceanography Marine Physical Laboratory Deep Tow and Sea Beam Group under Dr. Fred Spiess from 1982-84 and accompanied a number of expeditions throughout the Pacific Ocean. Headed NOAA's EEZ Mapping Project from 1987-90, directing the activities of five multibeam sounding vessels in waters of the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans. Since retirement from NOAA Corps in 1995, has been affiliated with NOAA Central Library and is a recognized authority on the history of ocean exploration and the history of NOAA. Serves on the US Board on Geographic Names (BGN) Advisory Committee on Undersea Features (ACUF) and conducts historical research for that body into the history of the discovery and naming of undersea features.
