## PUBLICATION OF DIGITAL TIDE TABLES

Dear Hydrographer,

1 At the 17<sup>th</sup> International Hydrographic Conference the IHO approved the report of the Tidal Committee (IHOTC) and tasked it to consider standards for Digital Tide Tables (DTT), in conjunction with the Committee on Hydrographic Requirements for Information Systems (CHRIS). The IHOTC gave some preliminary discussion to this topic at its 8<sup>th</sup> meeting in Halifax, Canada from 23 – 25 October 2007. The IHOTC concluded that as a first step it needed to assess the current status of the production and availability of DTTs together with any plans that Member States may have for their future production.

2 As reported to the Conference it is the view of the IHOTC that digital tide tables should have functionality and intelligence built into them and therefore electronic copies, for example, pdf versions of printed paper tide tables, are not considered to be DTTs.

3 In order to provide the IHOTC with the necessary information, Member States are kindly requested to complete the questionnaire at **Annex A and return it to the IHB by 31 January 2008**.
