## **NEW EDITION OF S-63 – IHO Data Protection Scheme** *Edition 1.1, March 2008*

Dear Hydrographer,

1 Reference a) reported on the endorsement of a draft new edition 1.1 of IHO publication S-63 – *IHO Data Protection Scheme* by the Committee on Hydrographic Requirements for Information Systems (CHRIS) at its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting in Rotterdam in November 2007, and invited Member States to review and comment on this draft.

2 The Bureau thanks the following Member States that provided responses, all which were supportive of the proposed new edition: Brazil, Canada, Cuba, Germany, Finland, France, Monaco, Norway and Portugal. France suggested some editorial changes that have now been included in the S-63 documentation. Germany provided a number of very useful and substantive comments which have been considered by the CHRIS Data Protection Scheme Working Group (DPSWG) and this has resulted in a number of improvements and clarifications to the new edition.

The finalised English version of Edition 1.1 of S-63 has now been posted on the IHO website (<u>www.iho.int</u> > Publications > Download List). French and Spanish versions will be posted on the website as soon as they are available. The supporting test data for S-63 e1.1 is currently in its final stage of development by the Norwegian Electronic Chart Centre (ECC) and will be placed on the IHO website as soon as it has been completed.

4 Edition 1.1 of S-63, dated March 2008, has now entered into force and supersedes the previous edition announced in reference b).

5 The Directing Committee thanks the UKHO, the ECC and all members of the DPSWG for their valuable support in preparing this new edition of S-63. Special thanks are conveyed to Mr. Richard Coombes and Mr. Jonathan Pritchard of the UKHO, who have been instrumental in this work.
