REQUEST FOR DIGITAL IMAGES

Dear Hydrographer,

- 1 Many national hydrographic offices/services and the IHB conduct events to promote their activities as well as the importance of hydrography in general. This usually culminates in the annual celebrations associated with World Hydrography Day. In order to better support such events, the IHB is seeking digital images from each Member State that can be used in a comprehensive slide show that will illustrate the range of operations associated with hydrography and the activities of the Member States of the IHO.
- The slide show will contain a minimum of text and will be configured to run as a continuous loop. Obviously, the images contained in the slide show would also be available to use as a source for other presentations. Once the slide show is compiled, subject to an appropriate range of images being supplied by Member States, a copy will be provided to each Member State for their own use.
- 3 Member States are asked to provide digital images in each of the following categories:

<u>Products</u>: extracts from modern charts (digital and paper)

nautical publications

digital modelling and simulation

Maritime Safety Information services (MSI)

End Users: hydrographic information and products in use

Human resources:

capacity building, training facilities

Your badge or logo as the national hydrographic authority.

4 To assist in the creation of an image catalogue, Member States are requested to complete and forward the table in Annex A together with their images. Please expand the table if more than one image is available for each category.

- 5 Images should be supplied in .jpeg format or another common Microsoft®-compatible format. Image resolution should be about 200-300dpi. For those States unable to supply digital images, high quality photographs are acceptable and will be scanned at the IHB.
