ADOPTION OF S-100 AS AN ACTIVE STANDARD

Reference: IHB CL70/2009 dated 26 October – *Recommendation by HSSC for IHO to adopt S-100 as an Active standard,*

Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. The IHB would like to thank the following Member States who replied to CL 70/2009 concerning the adoption of S-100 *Universal Hydrographic Data Model*, as an active standard: Algeria, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Denmark, Ecuador, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Korea, Rep. of, Latvia, Mexico, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, Papua New Guinea, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Singapore, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey, UK and USA.
- 2. All 42 responses support the proposal. There are currently 80 Member States of the IHO, two of whom have been suspended. Therefore in accordance with paragraph 6 of Article VI of the Convention on the IHO the majority required for adoption of a Technical Resolution is 40. As a result, S-100 *–Universal Hydrographic Data Model* has been adopted as an IHO Standard effective 1 January 2010.
