## 7<sup>th</sup> ABLOS BIENNIAL CONFERENCE

1 As reported at the reference the 7<sup>th</sup> ABLOS Biennial Conference will be held in Monaco in October 2012. The theme for the 7<sup>th</sup> Conference is:

## "UNCLOS IN A CHANGING WORLD"

2 The Government of Monaco has very kindly made the Salle du Ponant at the Centre de Rencontres Internationales (CRI), available for this Conference which will allow for a much greater number of participants; previous Conferences have always been oversubscribed.

This year the Conference has been programmed alongside the General Bathymetric Chart of the Oceans (GEBCO) Meetings and the GEBCO Science Day in particular with the intention of fostering dialogue between the two groups who have numerous matters of common interest. The GEBCO Science Day will take place on Tuesday 2 October and the ABLOS Conference from Wednesday 3 to Friday 5 October. All registrants for the ABLOS Conference are invited to attend the GEBCO Science Day and those attending the GEBCO Science Day may attend day 1 of the ABLOS Conference at no cost.

4. The IHB is also pleased to note that this year the ABLOS Conference is being organised in association with the Institut du Droit Économique de la Mer (INDEMER) of Monaco. Madame Annick de Marffy-Mantuano, President of the Scientific Council of INDEMER is a former Director of the United Nations Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea (DOALOS).
