#### Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. The 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Hydrographic Services and Standards Committee (HSSC-5) will take place from 5 to 8 November 2013, kindly hosted by the Maritime Safety Administration (MSA) of China in Shanghai.
- 2. This letter provides information on administrative details, the current status of actions arising from HSSC-4 (Taunton, United Kingdom, 25-28 September 2012 see reference), and sets out a draft agenda and timetable for HSSC-5.
- 3. Participation in HSSC-5 is open to all IHO Member States, and up to two delegates each representing Observer States and Non-Governmental International Organisations (NGIOs) recognised by the IHO. Registration forms for all delegates intending to participate in HSSC-5 should be submitted to the HSSC Secretariat (adcs@iho.int), copy to China MSA (hydro@msa.gov.cn) by 31 August 2013.
- 4. **HSSC Chair Group meeting**. HSSC-5 will be preceded by an informal meeting of the HSSC Chair Group in the afternoon of Monday, 4 November. In addition to the Chair of HSSC, this meeting will comprise the Chairs of HSSC Working Groups (WGs), the Vice-Chair and the Secretary of HSSC.
- 5. <u>Venue and Accommodation</u>. The meeting will be held at the Seagull On The Bund Hotel, in Shanghai. General and logistical information, such as details of available hotels, visa requirements, and a registration form for HSSC-5, have been posted on the IHO website (<a href="http://iho.int/mtg\_docs/com\_wg/HSSC/HSSC5/HSSC5Docs.htm">http://iho.int/mtg\_docs/com\_wg/HSSC/HSSC5/HSSC5Docs.htm</a>). Attendees should book their chosen hotel at their earliest convenience.
- 6. <u>Actions arising from HSSC-4</u>. The status of all actions arising from HSSC-4 is summarized in **Annex A**. Some actions are still pending. Those nominated for actions that remain outstanding are kindly requested to take action as necessary and report the status to the HSSC Secretariat (adcs@iho.int) as soon as possible.
- 7. **Draft Agenda and Timetable for HSSC-5**. A provisional agenda and time table for HSSC-5 is provided in **Annex B**. Associated documents, where known, have been listed. Member States are kindly requested to review the draft agenda and programme and provide any comments or proposals for new or amended subjects to the Secretary, **by 31 August 2013**. If necessary, a revised draft agenda and time table will be prepared and published on the IHO website.

8. <u>Submission Deadline for HSSC-5 Documents</u>. Documents intended for consideration at HSSC-5 should be submitted to the HSSC Secretariat in accordance with the "<u>Instructions for the Submission of Reports and Proposals for Consideration by HSSC</u>", as follows:
