

**PROPOSITIONS DE PROGRAMME DE TRAVAIL ET
DE BUDGET DE L'OHI POUR 2004**

Référence: a) LC du BHI 29/2003

Monsieur le directeur,

Conformément au cycle de planification du programme de travail approuvé par la décision 14 (b) de la XVIe CHI et sur la base du programme de travail 2003-2007 approuvé par la décision 14 (a) de cette même CHI, le programme de travail ainsi que le Budget de l'OHI ci-joints sont proposés à l'examen des Etats membres aux fins de commentaires et d'approbation. **Votre réponse devra parvenir au BHI avant le 30 octobre 2003, sur le formulaire fourni à cet effet en annexe D.**

Le BHI a apporté les modifications suivantes à la présentation du programme de travail afin d'en améliorer la clarté ainsi que l'utilité:

?? Le programme de travail de l'OHI 2003-2007 (Annexe A) a été modifié afin de préciser clairement les délais d'exécution des tâches et des diverses autres activités correspondant aux objectifs de chaque programme (1 à 5). Vos commentaires quant à l'utilité de cette présentation sous forme de tableau et à la programmation des diverses tâches spécifiques sont les bienvenus.

?? Le libellé des objectifs ainsi que des tâches spécifiques, utilisé dans le programme de travail de l'OHI 2003-2007, a été revu afin de le rendre plus explicite. L'activité attendue est énoncée plus clairement et la différenciation entre l'objectif (but) et la tâche (activité) est plus étroitement observée. Vos commentaires quant aux éclaircissements apportés sont les bienvenus.

?? Le Programme de travail de l'OHI pour 2004 (Annexe B) découle explicitement du programme de travail quinquennal.

En ce qui concerne la substance du programme de travail, les modifications suivantes ont été incorporées dans les documents communiqués en annexes A et B:

?? **Programme 2, Renforcement des capacités, Tâche 2.1.9** : Le projet MEHP (Marine Electronic Highway Project) (Déroit de Malacca) a été ajouté afin de refléter la participation de l'OHI à ce projet.

- ?? **Programme 3, Techniques et normes, Objectif 3.1.1** : Le groupe d'étude de la WEND est mentionné en tant qu'organe subsidiaire du Comité WEND, avec des réunions programmées, selon que de besoin, pour 2004.
- ?? **Programme 5, Développement général de l'OHI, Tâche 5.1.1** : Reflète les activités associées au SPWG.

Il est demandé aux Etats membres de bien vouloir faire parvenir au BHI commentaires et approbation concernant ce programme de travail avant le 30 octobre 2003. Les modifications proposées par les Etats membres seront examinées par le BHI lors de la préparation de la version finale du Programme 2004 qui sera mis en oeuvre dès janvier 2004.

Vous trouverez en annexe C la "Proposition de budget de l'OHI pour 2004" préparée conformément au Programme de travail 2004 et au Budget quinquennal approuvés par la XVIe CHI. Nous attirons votre attention sur les ajustements suivants apportés lors de la préparation de ce budget :

- ?? **A. Contributions** : Accroissement de 3% (de 2.316.468 € à 2.386.780 €), avec l'admission du Koweït en qualité d'Etat membre, l'ajustement du tonnage de la Yougoslavie et le rétablissement du Guatemala. Le nombre de parts est passé à 617 et la provision en cas de non - paiement par les Etats membres suspendus a été réduite à 6 parts.
- ?? **I . Dépenses de personnel** : Accroissement de 3% (de 1.715.058 € à 1.766.904 €), en raison des promotions normales appliquées au personnel, de l'évolution réglementaire des traitements ainsi que de l'inflation.
- ?? **I. d) Cotisations aux régimes de retraite** : Accroissement de 27% (de 144.069€ à 182.691€), afin de couvrir les cotisations requises aux plans de retraite des employés actuels. Le niveau de ces cotisations est fixé par les règlements.
- ?? **I . m) Pensions versées au personnel à la retraite** : Réduction de 18% (de 164.786 € à 135.000 €) en raison de l'affinement des prévisions relatives au paiement des pensions.
- ?? **II. a) Maintenance de l'équipement informatique** : Accroissement de 85% (de 20.720 € à 38.450 €), afin de tenir compte de la plus grande sophistication des systèmes informatiques ainsi que d'une plus grande dépendance vis à vis des contrats de maintenance.
- ?? **II. j) Honoraires des consultants** : Réduction de 23% (de 123.484€ à 95.000€ (IIg & Ili). Le recours accru à l'utilisation de consultants, qui avait été prévu, n'a pas été confirmé.

Les modifications susmentionnées ainsi que les divers autres ajustements mineurs apportés aux prévisions budgétaires de l'OHI pour 2004 ne requièrent pas l'approbation de la majorité des deux-tiers de tous les Etats membres. **Il est toutefois demandé aux Etats membres d'approuver le budget proposé en retournant au BHI le formulaire constituant l'annexe D à la présente, avant le 30 octobre 2003.**

Une dernière question d'ordre financier requérant votre attention concerne la décision 21 (a) de la XVIe CHI portant création d'un groupe de travail de la Commission des finances chargé d'examiner l'alignement des salaires du BHI sur ceux des Nations Unies. Le Comité de direction a le plaisir d'annoncer que cette étude, maintenant achevée, a fait l'objet d'un rapport. Ce dernier sera examiné lors d'une réunion spéciale du Comité restreint de la Commission des finances prévue fin septembre 2003. A l'issue de cette réunion, le rapport du groupe de travail ainsi que les conclusions du Comité restreint de la Commission des finances seront communiqués aux Etats membres pour information. Sur la base des commentaires formulés par les Etats membres, la Commission des finances étudiera la mise en œuvre des recommandations du groupe de travail et les ajustements budgétaires nécessaires qui seront soumis à l'approbation des Etats membres.
