Ronán Long holds the Jean Monnet Chair of European Law at the School of Law, National University of Ireland Galway. He read for his PhD at the School of Law at Trinity College Dublin and was the first recipient of the Michael Manahan Research Fellowship. He is the author/co-editor of five books on oceans law and policy including *Enforcing the Common Fisheries Policy* (Oxford, 2000); *Marine Resource Law* (Dublin, 2007), *Law, Science and Ocean Management* (Boston/Leiden, 2007), and *Legal Challenges in Maritime Security* (Boston/Leiden, 2008). He worked previously for the European Commission (1994–2002) and the Naval Service in Ireland (1981-1993). He acts as an adviser/consultant on marine related issues and provides commissioned work to public and private bodies including state agencies, foreign governments, industry representative organisations and the European institutions. As the Managing Director of Marine Law and Ocean Policy Research Services Ltd, he is participating in the ODEMM project with 15 European partners which is examining options for the implementation of the ecosystem approach in the marine environment. He is a keen offshore sailor and has represented Ireland at the top competitive level in ocean racing.
