## CBSC letter 2017

Dear colleagues,

Another busy year is soon coming to an end. As a tradition, now for the seventh time, I am sending you an annual letter to inform you about some major issues since our last meeting in Paramaribo.

First, I would like to highlight that Capacity Building is still and probably even more in focus of the IHO Secretariat and the Member States. At the first council meeting in October CB played an important role and it is obvious that our work is being particularly appreciated and seen as one of the major strategic endeavors of the IHO.

Based on the report of the IRCC chair, C-1 endorsed the proposal for increasing the capacity building support at the IHO Secretariat and tasked the Secretary-General to further investigate and report on the feasibility of recruiting a new regular staff member at the Secretariat and to install an interim solution on short term as a matter of urgency. You have been informed by Alberto already, that as a consequence, the Secretary-General decided that Ms Sandrine Brunel will be a full time Capacity Building Assistant starting on 1 January 2018. Sandrine has been supporting the IHO CB execution as a part time Assistant and I know that she will be an important contributor to CB in her new dedicated role. Welcome Sandrine to the CBSC on a full time basis! I would like to thank the Secretary General and the whole Secretariat for the flexibility in finding an interim solution so quickly.

There are more changes in our Subcommittee since the elections in Paramaribo with the new Vice-Chair Lamberto. We can welcome several new members. Vincent Lamarre (FR) replaced Eric Langlois and our former Vice-Chair Olumide Omotoso from Nigeria has been replaced by Ayodeji Olumide Olugbode. For the RSAHC we are waiting for the confirmation of Hamdan al Yahmadi (Oman) as the new CB-Coordinator, replacing Jeff Briant in this position (now responsible for only three regions).

I welcome all of the new members to our group and sincerely thank the former members Eric and Olumide.

I would like to thank you for your most valuable participation in the IHO capacity building initiative and I am looking forward to seeing you all in good health at the next CBSC meeting in Goa, India on the 30 May to 1 June 2018.
