Background: At present time navigational warnings and meteorological information are sent as a West and East Coastal Warning for the Northern Sea Route through the Inmarsat Safety Net. The quantity of promulgated Coastal Warning's for Western and Eastern parts of the Northern Sea Route for 2006, 2007 and 2008 years are listed below:

These transmissions will be continued until beginning of full operation of all 5 new NAVAREAs in Arctic waters.

- 1. Limits of planned propagation NAVAREA's XX and XXI warning through Safety Net and NAVTEX Tiksi are shown on the attached Scheme. Areas North from IOR Satellite, POR Satellite and Tiksi NAVTEX would be covered by NAVTEX transmissions on frequency 4209.5 kHz. Positions of HF radio stations will be determined later.
