1. Background:

The NAVAREA III Region covers the Mediterranean Sea from the meridian 005° 45'W, and the Black Sea. NAVAREA III warnings are sent from the Spanish Hydrographic Office (Instituto Hidrográfico de la Marina, IHM) through LES Burum over AOR-E.

Due to the next migration of the AORE satellite in September, the warnings are being also broadcast through Burum over IOR satellite. The IHM is making the arrangements with his Administration to move to SafetyNET II.

13.Summary

Regarding with the promulgation of navigational warnings in the Eastern Mediterranean Sea, the NAVAREA III Coordinator is maintaining discussions with staff associated with the safety of navigation from these coastal states via e-mail, and considers that cooperation and the level of coordination have improved from the situation before WWNWS-SC 9, particularly in matters on areas affected by navigational warnings.

In the Black Sea, regarding messages received from the Russian Federation for the north-western part of the Black Sea, Sea of Azov and Kerch Strait, the NAVAREA III Coordinator is passing these messages on to Ukraine to be transmitted by Odessa NAVTEX Station for the north-western part of the Black Sea and Berdiansk NAVTEX Station for Sea of Azov and Kerch Strait. Ukraine is transmitting these messages.
