1. Background:

NAVAREA XIX limits:

From a position on the Norwegian coastland at 65° 00'.00N to:

65° 00'.00N, 005° 00'.00W,

75° 00'.00N, 005° 00'.00W, west to a position on the Greenland coastline;

From the border between Norway and Russia (Inland) to:

69° 47'.68N 030° 49'.16E,

69° 58'.48N 031° 06'.24E,

70° 22'.00N 031° 43'.00E,

71° 00'.00N 030° 00'.00E, further north along the 030° 00'.00E meridian to

90° 00'.00N 030° 00'.00E,

90° 00'.00N 035° 00'.00W, south to the Greenland coastline along the 035° 00'.00W meridian.

The broadcasting of SafetyNET messages will be addressed to a rectangular area until the SafetyNET receiver modifications with the inclusion of the above boundary limits and its identification is in place.

Norway declared NAVAREA XIX to be in “Initial Operational Capability” (IOC) 1 July 2010 with broadcasts on SafetyNet and HF NBDP. The service is expected to be transitioned to “Full Operational Capability” (FOC) on 1 June 2011. During the IOC period, the Norwegian Coastal Administration will be providing a navigational warning service on an intermittent and test basis.

Navigational Warnings regarding positions at or above 76°N will be broadcast both on SafetyNet and on High Frequency Narrow Band Direct-Printing (HF NBDP) frequency 8416,5 kHz.

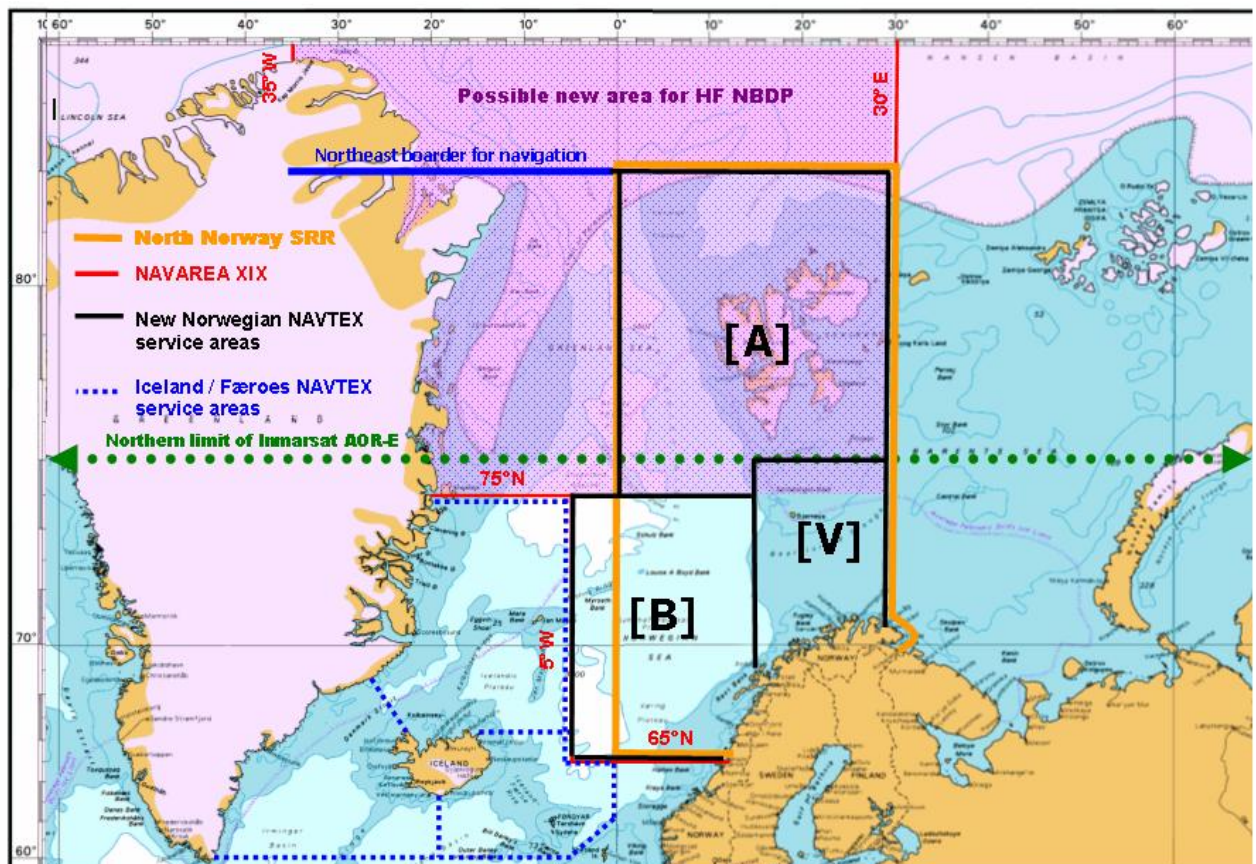
