- (ii) Coastal Warnings for Mauritius and Reunion are broadcast by LES Aussaguel at 0040 and 1240 UTC.
- (iii) Coastal Warnings for Mayotte are broadcast by LES Aussaguel at 0330 and 1530 UTC.

 - (i) LES Pune (India) 0900 and 1800 UTC (for North of Equator)
 - (ii) LES Aussaguel 0130 and 1330 UTC (for Mauritius/Reunion and South of Equator). Tropical Cyclone warnings prepared and issued by Reunion 0000, 0600, 1200 and 1800UTC

- (e) Operational Points of Contact for National Co-ordinators within NAVAREA. Due to the instability in Somalia, information of National Coordinator could not be obtained.



(a) <u>NAVTEX Chain</u>. Seven new NAVTEX stations are being established along the Indian coast and island territory. The preparation of technical specifications and system architecture for the NAVTEX Chain is being undertaken. The system is likely to be operational by end 2012. The details of the proposed NAVTEX Stations are as tabulated below:-

6. **Contingency Planning**.

In case of failure of LES Pune, NAVAREA VIII warnings can be transmitted through LES 321 Aussaguel, (Operator Vizada). The backup facility was used in March & April 2011 due to technical problems in LES Pune.

7. Capacity Building:-

(a) <u>IOC on Job Training workshop</u>. A Multibeam afloat training workshop was undertaken for the participants of foreign countries under the tutelage of the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) as a part of the Coast-Map-IO Project from 12 to 22 Dec 10. Nine participants (Thailand 03, Myanmar 02, Mozambique 02 and Sri Lanka 02) attended the workshop.

(b) MSI Workshop. A national Maritime Safety Information Workshop was conducted at the National Hydrographic Office, Dehradun, India on 27 Jul 11. Delegates from various national agencies and armed forces attended the workshop. The aim of the workshop was to discuss issues concerning promulgation of NAVAREA VIII warnings among the stakeholders of the marine environment.

8. Other Activities:

- (a) NAVAREA VIII representative attended the Regional Conference on Worldwide Navigational warnings at Tokyo, from, 19 to 21 Oct 10, under the aegis of the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department Japan Coast Guard. The meeting discussed the aspects regarding overlay of navigational warnings in ECDIS.
- (b) <u>HYDROIND-2011</u>. The international HYDRO-IND 2011, Seminar and exhibition was conducted on 03 & 04 Mar 11 at New Delhi, India. The theme for the seminar was "Hydrography: An instrument for regional cooperation and maritime safety".
- (c) <u>NIOHC Meeting</u>. The eleventh North Indian Hydrographic Commission (NIOHC) meeting was conducted on 01 &02 Mar 11 at New Delhi, India under the Chairmanship of Rear Admiral Lambert, the Chief Hydrographer, UKHO.
