1. Background:

The NAVAREA III Region covers the Mediterranean (from meridian 005° 45'W) and Black Seas.

Radio Navigational Warnings in the NAVAREA III region are sent from the Spanish Hydrographic Institute (IHM) to Burum Land Earth Station (LES), in The Netherlands using a TCP/IP (Internet) connection. From Burum the navigational warnings are sent to AOR-E SafetyNet Satellite for broadcasting over the whole region.

-Broadcasting times:

On receipt of information, and scheduled broadcasts at 1200UTC and 2400UTC.

-Meteorological information: broadcast by METAREA III Coordinator, Greece.

-Satellite Service Provider:

Stratos Mobile.

4. Operational Issues:

-4 new NAVTEX stations become operational since the last WNWNS3:

La Maddalena, Sellia Marina, and Mondolfo from Italy and Kelibia from Tunisia.

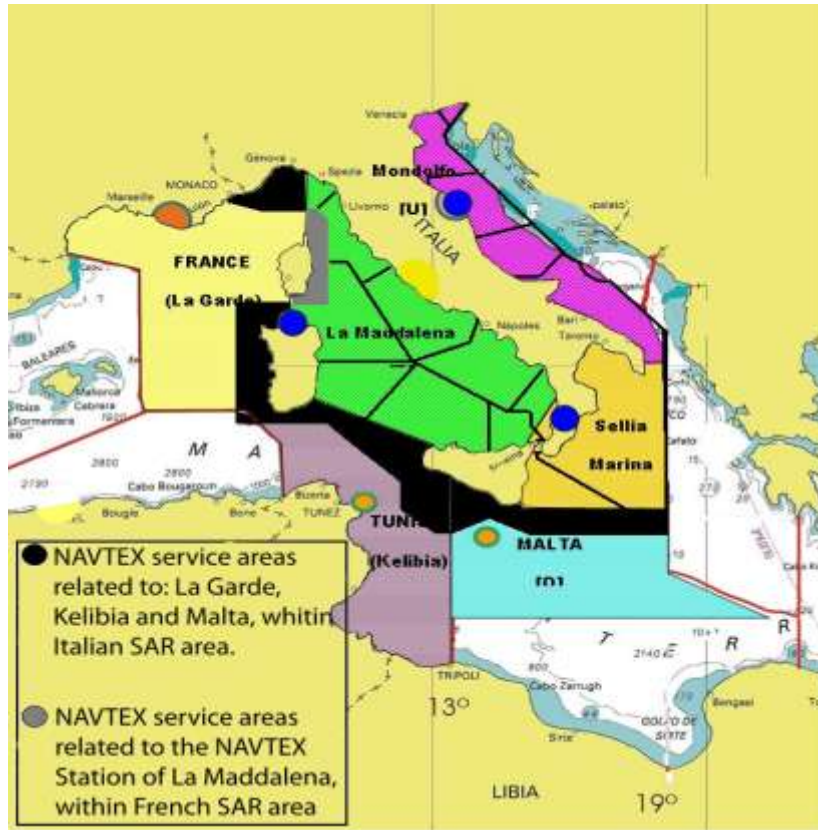
The following Italy stations were decommissioned: Cagliari, Trieste and Augusta. To summarize, there are 25 NAVTEX stations broadcasting in the international service.

-Because of the situation in Libya, this NAVAREA III Coordinator does not have knowledge on the progress of the expected station in Surt. Therefore, this zone is only covered with NAVAREA messages from other areas via SafetyNet.

-The Italian Coast Guard has been reporting a problem of overlapping between the NAVTEX service areas of the stations of La Magdalena , Sellia Marina (Italy), Kelibia (Tunisia), Malta, La Garde (France) and SAR areas of Italy, Malta and France. This problem arose when the NAVTEX services areas were established for the NAVAREA III area, in the meeting held in Monaco in 2006.

-We have been publishing warnings of gun exercises over the islands of the Aegean Sea for the whole year. These warnings have been broadcast for years. As these warnings are in force all year and every year, we propose that these areas must be charted to stop broadcasting these warnings, but Greece puts emphasis in broadcasting these notices.

-We do not have communication with the national coordinator of Egypt. We only receive requested warnings via postal mail and therefore these notices are delivered with too much delay. In general, we have little information exchange with either the National Navtex Coordinators or National coordinators.



Each week, the IHM publishes the bulletin “Avisos a los Navegantes” (Notices to Mariners) containing the number of NAVAREA III in force, so that mariners can browse in the web site.

The bulletin contains also the NAVAREA III warnings originated during the previous week. Besides this, we publish NAVAREA II in force in both the bulletin and the web site.
