1. Background:

The NAVAREA III Region covers the Mediterranean Sea from meridian 005° 45'W, and Black Sea.

Radio Navigational Warnings in the NAVAREA III region are sent from the Spanish Hydrographic Institute(IHM) to Burum Land Earth Station (LES), in The Netherlands using a TCP/IP (Internet) connection.

From Burum the navigational warnings are sent to AOR-E SafetyNet Satellite for broadcasting over the whole region.

-Broadcasting times:

On receipt of information, and scheduled broadcasts at 1200UTC and 2400UTC.

-Meteorological information: broadcast by METAREA III Coordinator, Greece.

-Satellite Service Provider:

Stratos Mobile.

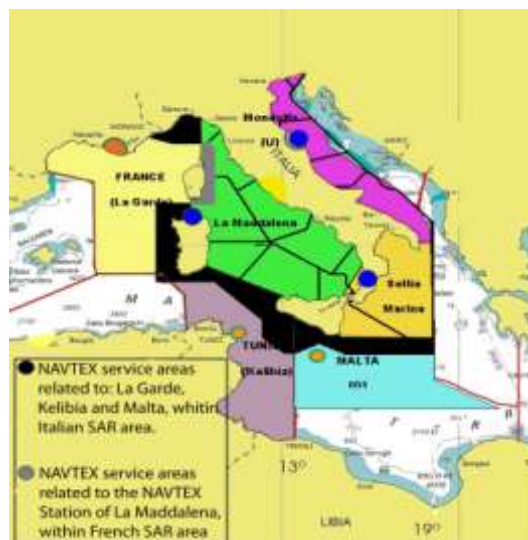
4. Operational Issues:

-The configuration of NAVTEX service areas in the Mediterranean Sea changed since the 1ST of January 2012, with the fully operational NAVTEX stations of La Maddalena, Sellia Marina, and Mondolfo from Italy, and Kelibia from Tunisia.

-Owing to the outage of Kelibia since February , and without any further notice about them resuming broadcasting MSI, there are 2 gaps for disseminating warnings via NAVTEX stations, Surt and Kelibia. These areas only receive MSI via SAFETYNET .

-In general, the flow of information between NAVAREA III Coordinator and National coordinators is scarce. The Italian Coast Guard is the main authority who reports the incidents that take place in the surrounding sea areas.

-The Italian Coast Guard keeps on reporting the problem of overlapping between the NAVTEX service areas of the stations of La Magdalena , Sellia Marina(Italy), Kelibia(Tunisia), Malta, La Garde(France) and SAR areas of Italy, Malta and France.





- The broadcasting of gunning exercises in the Aegean Sea continue for the whole year, via Greek NAVTEX stations.
- NAVAREAIII Coordinator has not yet been able to communicate with the Egyptian Authority. We still receive delayed request warnings via postal mail.
- The IHM publishes, every week, the bulletin “Avisos a los Navegantes” (Notices to Mariners), also in web site. The address of the web site is as follows:

The bulletin contains the number of each NAVAREA III warning in force, and the text of the NAVAREA III warning originated during the previous week, both in English and Spanish. The bulletin also contains all NAVAREA II warnings in force in English.

13. Summary:

In general, there are few communications between NAVAREA III Coordinator and national coordinators. The Italian Coast Guard is the main authority who is in contact with NAVAREA III Coordinator. Because of the current situation of Kelibia without further notice for transmitting MSI again for months, the only warnings that can be received in the surrounding area is via SAFETYNET. This situation is the same in the area surrounding the north Libya coast, where the planned station of Surt is still not working.
