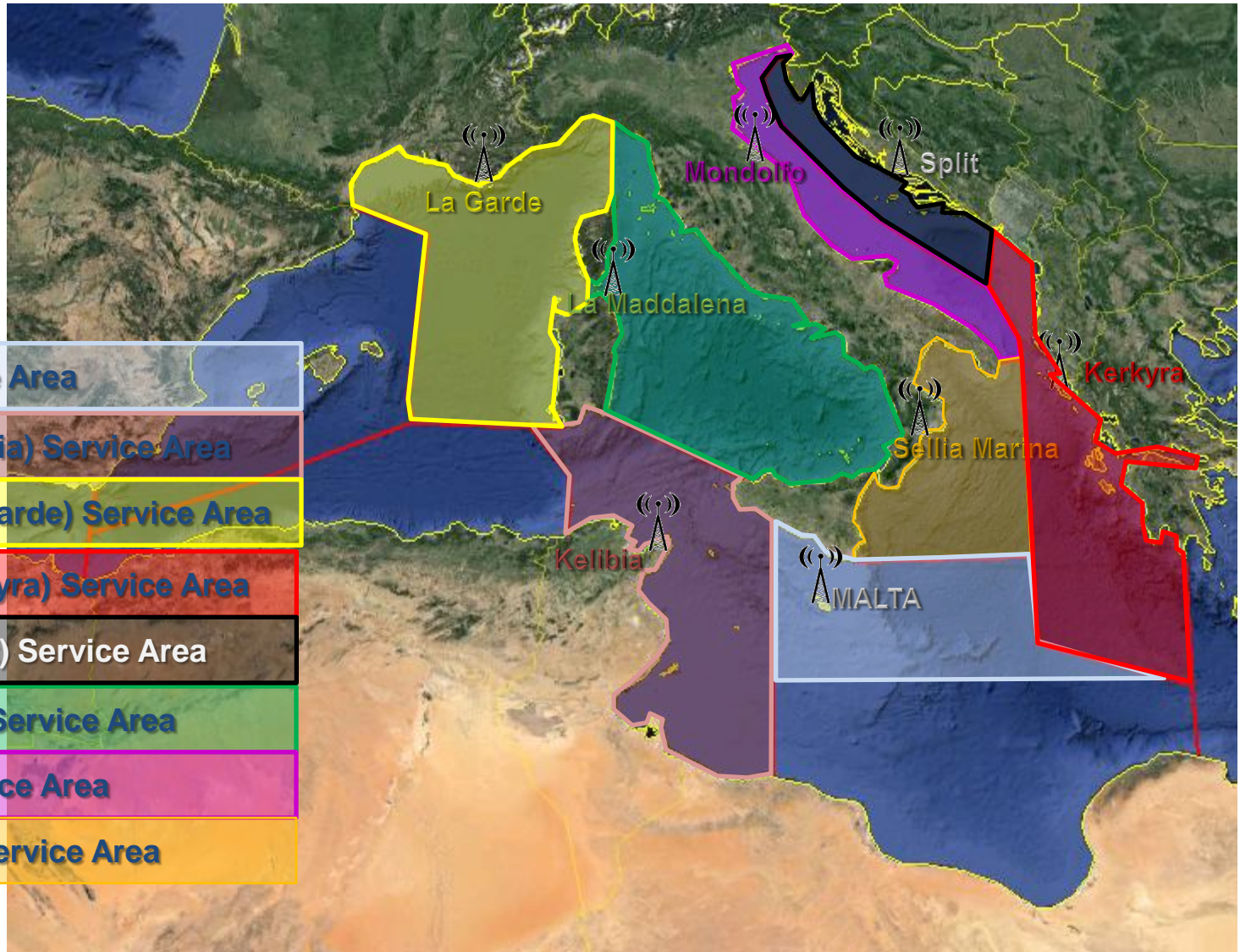

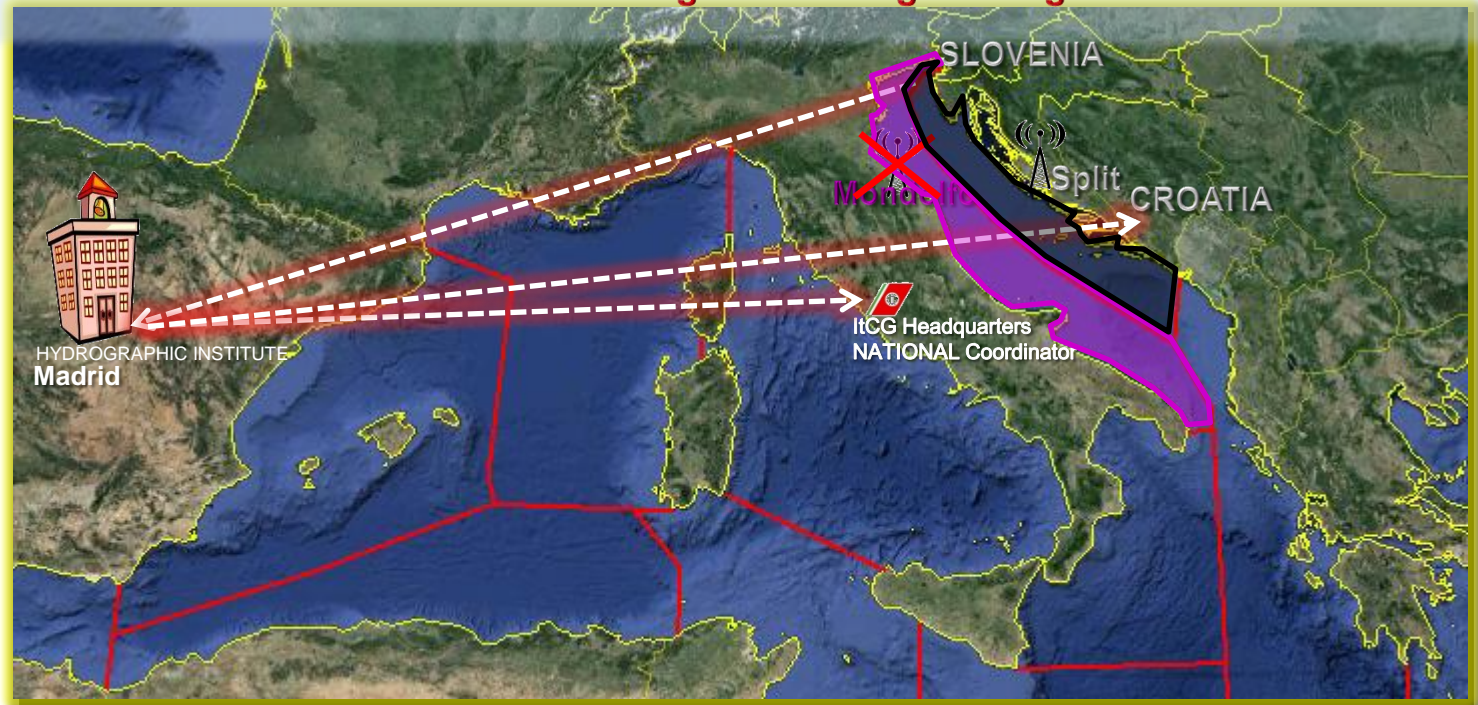
- Sellia Marina Station FAILURE

In cooperation with other States

2ndCase: Collaboration with Slovenia (Mondolfo station)

- **REQUEST:** Navtex broadcast for Slovenian navy
- **NAVAREA III coordinator:** Request collaboration to Italy and Croatia.
Even though Slovenia is inside Croatia SAR area coverage, it is closer to the Italian NAVTEX Station. So Italy, through Mondolfo Station, is able to broadcast warnings originated by Slovenia. If Italy is unable to provide assistance, information will be re-sent to Croatian station.
- **Mondolfo Navtex Station will ensure the service sending the warning messages**
