1. Background:

The NAVAREA III Region covers the Mediterranean Sea from meridian 005° 45'W, and Black Sea.

Radio Navigational Warnings in the NAVAREA III region are sent from the Spanish Hydrographic Institute(IHM) to Burum Land Earth Station (LES), in The Netherlands using a TCP/IP (Internet) connection.

From Burum the navigational warnings are sent to AOR-E SafetyNet Satellite for broadcasting over the whole region.

-Broadcasting times:

On receipt of information, and scheduled broadcasts at 1200 UTC and 2400UTC.

-Meteorological information: broadcast by METAREA III Coordinator, Greece.

-Satellite Service Provider:

4. Operational Issues:

-After the WWNWS 5 held in Monaco, The NAVAREA III Coordinator invited the relevant representatives of National Coordinators of the Central Mediterranean to hold a meeting to discuss the problem of the lack of NAVTEX Service in this area.

Only Malta offered its NAVTEX Service to broadcast the warnings within the area of Kelibia, that brought about that Tunisia should send its navigational warnings by email to Malta. But Tunisia continues just sending his navigational warnings to the NAVAREA III Coordinator that are broadcast as NAVAREA III warnings by SAFETYNET.

After more than 2 years of the breakdown of the Kelibia station, this Coordinator has no further news about the operational status of this station.

-Action WWNWS4 3.2.III.The situation regarding Egypt has not changed. The NAVAREA III Coordinator only receives delayed requested navigational warnings via postal mail.

-The IHM publishes, every week, the bulletin “Avisos a los Navegantes” (Notices to Mariners), also in web site. The address of the web site is as follows:

The bulletin contains the number of each NAVAREA III warning in force, and the text of the NAVAREA III warning originated during the previous week, both in English and Spanish. The bulletin also contains all NAVAREA II warnings in force in English.

The main problem in the NAVAREA III area is the lack of dissemination of MSI by the International Navtex Service in the relevant areas of the coasts of Tunisia and Sicilian Channel in the Central Mediterranean, because of the breakdown of the Kelibia station. This Coordinator has no evidence that this station would be operational again.
