

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# Significance

- In some regional areas there is a limited availability of MSI. Full GMDSS facilities do not exist across the whole region.
- To increase the coordination and collaboration between the National Coordinator and NAVAREA Coordinator







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### Outcomes

- Be informed of all events that could significantly affect the safety of navigation within their coastal region.
- Assess all information in the light of expert knowledge
- Draft warnings in accordance with international standards
- Pass to NAVAREA Coordinator, quickest means possible.

Warm greetings to all!





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### Barbados



All Firing will be done at surface level.

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
