Proposal for new INT abbreviation: MRCC (Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre)

Executive Summary: An INT abbreviation "MRCC" (Maritime Rescue Co-ordination

Centre) is needed for a better identification by all users for functions defined internationally in the GMDSS (Global Maritime Distress and

Safety System).

Introduction / Background

A French MRCC (Jobourg Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre) asks SHOM to use "Jobourg MRCC" (and "Jobourg VTS") on charts instead the French name of this MRCC which is CROSS Jobours (CROSS: Centre Régional Opérationnel de Surveillance et de Sauvetage). The reason is a better identification by all users for functions defined internationally in the GMDSS (Global Maritime Distress and Safety System).

Analysis / Discussion

There are different sorts of centres within the GMDSS organization:

MRCC: Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre

MRSC: Maritime Rescue co-ordination Sub-Centre (linked with MRCC) JRCC: Joint Rescue Co-ordination Centre (aeronautical and maritime RCC)

JRSC: Joint Rescue Sub-Center

The abbreviation RCC is also used but it can indicate an aeronautical Rescue Co-ordination Centre.

These abbreviations are official GMDSS abbreviations.

The abbreviation the most collectively known is MRCC. The others could be unknown by the users.

Conclusions

The abbreviation MRCC has then all the characteristics to be an INT abbreviation.

Recommendations

To adopt MRCC as an INT abbreviation. As "MRCC" would be generally a part of a name of a centre (ex: Jobourg MRCC) and not coastal function (as CG or SS), there is no need to add a new symbol using "MRCC" in INT1 section T.

Justification and Impacts

- better identification by all users for functions defined internationally in the GMDSS.

Action required of CSPCWG

The CSPCWG is invited to endorse the proposal to include MRCC in the INT abbreviations list for MS approval.
