<b>Executive Summary:</b>	The purpose of the paper is to discuss the possibility to convert our national symbol used for "Trawling prohibited" into an international symbol

### Introduction / Background

Our hydrographic office uses a national symbol to define an area in which trawling is prohibited.

### Analysis / Discussion

We suggest to insert this symbol (6mm x 4mm) to define the nature of the restriction both in the INT1 and in the S-4, e.g:



### Conclusions

With this symbol we could avoid writing on the chart the legend "Trawling prohibited" (or equivalent) increasing readability and standardization.

### Justification and Impacts

If this suggestion is accepted, it will be necessary to modify S-4 at B-439.3, B-439.4 and update the INT1 inserting the new item, probably in N 21.1.
