How to get to Rostock and where to stay

The city

How to get there

Rostock has a small airport of its own, Rostock-Laage, which offers a limited number of domestic flights to and from Stuttgart and Cologne.

Better (and cheaper) options would be via Hamburg Fuhlsbüttel Airport or Berlin Tegel Airport

There are regular, more or less hourly train services between Hamburg Hauptbahnhof (main railway station), Berlin "Zoologischer Garten" and Rostock Hauptbahnhof. The on-line train time table of the national railway company "Die Bahn" is available at http://www.db.de/site/bahn/en/start.html

Rostock City itself is not too big. You can easily reach the congress hotel by taxi or tram (four stations to the city centre using line no 5 or 6) in no more than 15 minutes. If you need any help with the travel arrangements, please contact madeleine.kern@bsh.de.
