How to reach Helsinki

Helsinki-Vantaa international airport (HEL) has several daily non-stop connections from various cities in Asia and North America and of course from all major airports in Europe.

International railway connections via St. Petersburg, Russia

Ferry connections from Tallinn, Estonia and Stockholm, Sweden

How to move around in Helsinki area

There is an extensive public transport network in Helsinki region. Tickets are valid in buses, trams, local trains, subway and public ferry.

Multi-day ticket card for Helsinki city zone is recommended for either four days (17.50€) or three days (14€) depending on your stay. On trips between airport and city you need a regional ticket (4€).

Single tickets can be bought from vending machines, bus drivers or train personnel. Multi-day ticket cards can be bought from all R-kiosks in the Helsinki metropolitan area, Stockmann department stores and Travel Card service points. Validity period for a multi-day ticket card begins the first time you show it to a card reader machine.

Taxi between airport and city costs 30-40€

Meeting place can be easily reached by means of public transport from all parts of Helsinki, since it's located right next to Pasila railway station (all trains stop at the station). Tram lines 7A, 7B and 9 have stops next to the station as well as buses 23, 58 and 69 for example.

From Pasila railway station hall walk through a pedestrian bridge to the bulky government office building. Right side of bridge takes you straight to an indoor 'mall'. Stairs to our reception are at the far end of the mall.




