#### Introduction / Background

- 1. Section 2.3 of the Rules of Procedure (ROPs) of the HSSC states: "The Chair and Vice-Chair shall be a representative of a Member State. The election of the Chair and Vice-Chair shall be decided at the first meeting after each ordinary session of the Assembly and shall be determined by vote of the Member States present and voting."
- 2. By IHO CL 16/2019, IHO Member States were informed that Mr Michael Prince (Australia) had decided to step down from his position as HSSC Vice-Chair. A call for nominations was made subsequently, inviting Member States to submit the names of their candidates for an election to be held at the beginning of the HSSC-11 meeting, for the Vice-Chair position. Member States were also invited to note that another election for the positions of Chair and Vice-Chair would be held again at HSSC-12, in accordance with the HSSC Rules of Procedure.

### **Analysis / Discussion / Voting Procedure**

- 3. The IHO Secretariat thanks the three Member States that responded to the IHO CL 16/2019 by submitting nominations: Canada, Sweden and United Kingdom.
- 4. For the position of HSSC Vice-Chair, the nominations received as of 30 April 2019 are:
  - Mr Louis Maltais (Canada);
  - Mr Magnus Wallhagen (Sweden);
  - Mr Thomas Mellor (United Kingdom).
- 5. Mr Louis Louis Maltais is the Director of Hydrospatial Services and Support at the Canadian Hydrographic Service (CHs) and also former Vice-Chair of the Tides Water Level Current Working Group.
- 6. Mr Magnus Wallhagen is Head of Production in the Swedish Hydrographic Office (SHO) and also the BSHC representative in the IHO-EU Network Working Group.
- 7. Mr Thomas Mellor is Head of OEM Technical Support and Digital Standards in the UKHO and also the Chair of the ENC Standards Maintenance Working Group.
- 8. Mr Louis Maltais', Mr Magnus Wallhagen's and Mr Thomas Mellor's nominations and short biographies are posted on the HSSC-11 webpage.
- 9. Each Member State having a representative physically present at the HSSC-11 meeting will be

allowed to cast one vote.

- 10. Voting for the position of Vice-Chair will be conducted by secret ballot.
- 11. Ballots will be counted and the results announced by the representative of the IHO Secretariat.
- 12. In case of a tie in the first ballot among the two candidates obtaining the largest number of votes, a run-off ballot shall be organised between these candidates.
- 13. The Vice-Chair elected will take office immediately at the conclusion of the election.
