Scheme Status:

- → Scheme participants now at 238 (218 2012).
- Support to scheme continues from group membership
- Group meeting in Feb 2013
 - New Edition for S-100
 - Reviewed migration plans for S-63 1.1
 - Considered issues over migration
 - Requests for clarification



DPSWG9 Meeting summary

- Three main elements
 - Request for assistance / clarification from IEC for support to 61174. A section on up to datedness drafted as as S63 annex.
 - To be published in 2014. <u>No impact</u> to oems or users. No need or desire to impact users through changes to existing std. Changes will complement iec61174 and give benefit to users.
 - Minor typos and clarifications + S64 update
 - Migration to S-63 edition 1.1.
 - The New Edition.
 - New edition guidelines agreed
 - Split proposed between S-100 and S-63
 - Structure, Algorithms, required metadata



Migration to S-63 edition 1.1

The benefits (Why)

- Elimination of error messages experienced by end users
- Introduction of large media support
- Compliance across all participants with latest version of data protection scheme.

+ The methods (How)

- Duplicate systems for distribution in place
- Contact and promotion with distributors to establish age of customer systems
- Migration of customers via one time process. Test dataset for ECDIS.
- Support to customers with problems
- Media migration
- Cutover and discontinuation of 1.0 systems

The timetable (When)

- Default offering now 1.1 to customers
- Large media in place
- Standards compliance highlighted to end users



Some higher level perspective

- The migration to S63 1.1 shows the difficulties of the current regime in keeping end users up to date with standards
- The end user and ECDIS manufacturer have no mandatory need to keep a pre type-approved system up to date as standards develop.
- This is a difficult environment to introduce change to even when it benefits the user. S100 model of flexible standards for the future should be a model in distribution too.
- + From DPSWG perspective the working group structure
 - Must help existing and future users of the scheme (support)
 - Must contribute to a more simplified, streamlined and harmonised operation (development)



Must apportion resources better internally and externally.

The current standard

- No structural changes needed
- No impact on current end users proposed so no "upgrades" required.
- Current items being processed are
 - Support IEC proposal for an ECDIS report on up to date status of chart holdings within a service.
 - Clarifies how ECDIS should report update status to user
 - Annex drafted with example content of report
 - Introduction with new edition of IEC61174
 - Minor typos and clarifications. No end user or distributor impact



New edition of standard

- Structure will remain as current. IHB to administer the scheme and enrol/maintain participants
- Algorithms remain in place (but pluggable)
- Formats to be upgraded/simplified.
- Data integrity to be dealt with by S-100. Can be used by all S-10x products
- Simplified data management for ECDIS
- Framework to be submitted for review/modification at DPSWG10
- The benefits of hindsight!



Obstacles!

- + Normal resource conflicts.
 - Core group members have many commitments
 - Hard to split New Edition from working issues.
- Meeting scheduling
 - Difficult to schedule the right people together
 - Will try this year to combine with other meetings
- Drafting/Testing



DPSWG work plan

- Work within whatever structure is in place to secure member state requirements for data protection and integrity
- Continue to support the operation of the scheme and the IHB staff involved
- Draft new content to support S-100 products. Data integrity mechanisms to be separate from data protection and distribution.
- Release new minor edition including status reports to complement IEC 61174 new edition
- + Complete update of S-64 test data content.



Action required of HSSC

 - Drafting of new edition of standard
