Principal activities and achievements

- Maintained high level of engagement in the WG
 - 29 Member States represented + 3 industry representatives
 - > 20 responses to CSPCWG Letters (13 Letters in reporting period)
- + Meetings
 - CSPCWG10, Wellington, NZ, January 2014
 - INT1 Sub-WG (short meeting in conjunction with CSPCWG10)
- + S-4 Part B revision completed
 - Edition 4.5.0, October 2014 (Section B-500 et al)
 - Ongoing maintenance of S-4 (CSPCWG business as usual but now iaw Resolution 2/2007)
 - INT1 revision (DE, ES, FR, WG Secretary)

Problems or outstanding issues

- + Future of the paper chart
- + Bathymetry and maximum authorised draught
- + WG name, scope, direction: HSSC6-04.2E (HSSC5-05.5C)
- + Non-IHO seals on INT charts: HSSC6-05.5C

- + Resources and technical WG collaboration



Future work programme

- Standards, symbols, specifications: e.g. minimum depth and maximum authorised draught; covered and dangerous cargo berths; INT1 Section V; QR codes; chart product consistency
- S-11 Part A: Progress pending feedback from NSEHWG and WENDWG
- + INT1: FR, DE and ES scheduled during 2015
- + Lessons learned from marine incidents
- Advice: ICCWGs; MS; capacity building
- + Meeting CSPCWG11, Rostock, Germany, April 2015



Action requested of HSSC

At CSPCWG10 (January 2014), examples were presented regarding the possible inclusion on paper INT charts of seals of HOs that are not IHO Member States.

These included:

- Baltic Sea (Region E) a non-Member State seeking to publish an INT chart.
- A FR-produced INT chart off Benin and Togo, West Africa. As producer, FR added the seals of both nations, neither of which are MS.



- When using the IHO seal in a paper chart, this should only be with the authority of an IHO Member State which can reasonably claim part ownership and adherence to IHO standards (that is, of an organisation of which it is a member).
- + If not a MS, the seal is being used to imply an authority which the producer organisation is not empowered to claim.
- + This stance has been discussed and agreed with the IHB.

 - 53 ENC producers
 - 41 provide full MSI services for paper charts
 - 35 forecast to provide full ENC update services by 2015
