Principal activities and achievements

 - INT1 Sub-WG (short meeting in conjunction with NCWG1)

 - Election of Officers
 - Revised Terms of Reference and Procedures (Annexes B and C)



Principal activities and achievements (2)

+ S-4

- Preparation of Edition 4.6.0 (HSSC6-05.6D)
- + INT1 revision (DE, ES, FR, WG Secretary)
 - English (DE) Oct 2015; Spanish Nov 2015; French Jan 2016
- + S-11 Part A
 - Draft prepared by NSEHWG and submitted for NCWG review April 2015.
 - NCWG review conducted by correspondence (NCWG Letters 6 and 14/2015 and Letter from IHB the INT Chart Coordinators/ICCWG).
 - Feedback from Chile advice required from HSSC (HSSC7-05.6E).



Problems or outstanding issues

- + Data Quality: Indicators for chart users
- + S-4 and IHO Resolution 2/2007
- + Information Overlay Services (new Work Items approved at HSSC6).
- + The future of the paper chart
- + The future of S-4 as the chart specifications of the IHO



Future work programme

- Standards, symbols, specifications: e.g. "light pipe" aids to navigation; sub-categorisation of restricted areas (previously discussed by TSMAD); suspended underwater pipelines; INT1 Section V
- + S-11 Part A (including its Annexes)
- Lessons learned from marine incidents
- + Advice: ICCWGs; MS; capacity building
- + Meeting NCWG2, IHB, Monaco, April 2016



Action requested of HSSC

- + Note the NCWG Report to HSSC7: HSSC7-05.6A
- + Endorse continued activity of the WG supporting:
 - Standardisation and currency of nautical charts
 - Guidance to chart compilers, including Capacity Building
 - Nautical cartography principles across chart formats
 - Forward-looking review of status of the paper chart
- + Approve the draft Terms of Reference at Annex B
- + Approve the CSPCWG Work Plan at Annex E
 - Approve the proposed revisions to S-4 Edition 4.5.0 at paper HSSC7-05.6D; and submission of Edition 4.6.0 to IHO Member States via IHO CL for approval to publish.

Action requested of HSSC (2)

- Discuss the draft revision of S-11 Part A as included in paper HSSC7-05.6E and related response from Chile, and advise NCWG of a way forward.
- Note the concerns of the NCWG over the interpretation and application of IHO Resolution 2/2007
- Note that recommendation 3 included in paper HSSC6-05.5D is not within the remit of the NCWG, and is being addressed by the WENDWG and the IRCC.
- + **Approve** the establishment of a Project Team under the NCWG, operating under the draft Terms of Reference and Work Plan at Annex D, to further investigate the future style and content of S-4 (to be activated post-HSSC8).

Action requested of HSSC (3)

 Approve the addition of a new Work Item in the NCWG Work Plan to investigate the options for subdividing the categories and associated restrictions of restricted area in association with former TSMAD Work Item.
