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Background

Galway Statement (24 May 2013)

EU, Canada, USA "intend to advance our shared vision of an Atlantic Ocean that is healthy, resilient, safe, productive, understood and treasured so as to promote the well-being, prosperity, and security of present and future generations"

- Implementation through the Atlantic Ocean Research Alliance (AORA) and the Galway Implementation Committee (Canada/DFO, USA/NOAA, EU/DG RTD)
- Link to Horizon 2020
- Seabed Mapping component
 - Initial workshop in Dublin, December 2014 (EU, Canada, USA and Brazil)
 - 1st North Atlantic Seabed Mapping Meeting, Brussels, February 2015
 - Chaired by Mr Alan Stevenson, British Geological Survey (BGS) / EuroGeoSurvey Marine Geology Expert Group (EGS MGEG)
 - > IHB invited through NOAA (not the EC!)
 - > general discussions of ideas and challenges for seabed mapping
 - considerations on improving linkages across programmes and leveraging existing ocean exploration data, knowledge and infrastructure
 - > agreement to identify a target pilot area in the North Atlantic and the minimum data required
 - > acknowledgment of the requirement to raise awareness of the need for mapping the Atlantic
 - > agreement to encourage engagement with the GEBCO project and the use of the DCDB

 - 2nd North Atlantic Seabed Mapping Meeting, Cork, Ireland, July 2015
 - > review of related activities and projects
 - > further discussion on pilot project areas
 - Further discussion on the connection with GEBCO and consideration of DCDB development and opportunity for specific provisions
 - stablishment of the Atlantic Seabed Mapping International Working Group (ASMIWG)
 - 3rd ASMIWG Meeting, St John's, Newfoundland, Canada, October 2015
 - > reports on transects in the North Atlantic and the Arctic
 - > agreement to use DCDB as project data store
 - > looking for harmonization with Transatlantic Ocean Literacy Working Group
 - discussions on the preparation of draft recommendations to the Galway Implementation Committee (initial deadline of end of 2015 not met ...)
 - > review of draft terms of reference and rules of procedure
 - Next meetings
 - > ASMIWG-4, New Orleans, USA, in conjunction with Ocean Sciences 2016 Meeting, 21-26 Feb
 - > ASMIWG-5, Ireland, mid-summer (tbd)
 - > IHB investigates the possibility to arrange back-to-back meeting with the CSBWG in the second half of 2016
