5. Status of IRCC actions (relevant for the RSAHC):

Action on all RSAHC relevant points has been taken.

Pursuant to the Action No. 11 of the IRCC 10 and correspondence coordination with the RSAHC Member States, Mr. Saeid Parizi from IR of Iran has been selected as permanent CB Coordinator for the RSAHC region since 2018.

In this regard, a regional capacity building working group has been proposed and will be established subject to consent of the Member States.
