6. INT Chart Scheme

The first SAIHC INT Chart Coordinating Committee Meeting was convened in the margins of the 9th SAIHC Conference and the discussions were found to be of great value. Good charting progress was made in charting Region H with reference to the INT Chart Catalogue, IHO S-11. Seven new INT Charts has been produced and it is expected that more successes

will be reported at the next SAIHC Conference.

7. ENC Production Status

ENC coverage is similar to that of INT paper chart coverage and this is mainly due to the sterling efforts of the SAIHC Member States with charting responsibilities. Deficiencies in charting coverage will only be improved through modern surveys as the lack of data is the main inhibiter.

8. Capacity Building Projects

The 2012 IHO Capacity Building Work Programme allowed for the provision of support for the delivery and attendance of a Phase 1 Skills Training Course with the objective of giving participants a highly practical introduction to the assessment and promulgation of navigational significant information. The course was held at Fish Hoek, South Africa from 26-30 November 2012 and very good attendance was achieved with only two Associate MS not attending. Technical visits to Kenya, Tanzania and Mozambique were also achieved by experts. SAIHC MS contributing staff members for technical visits were UK, Norway, Portugal and South Africa.

9. Venue and date of next meeting

The 9th SAIHC Conference will be held in Lisbon, Portugal on 18 and 19 September 2013.
